Used to clean: Hospital instruments, laboratory ware, optical components, pharmaceutical and cosmetics manufacturing equipment, tissue culture ware, plate glass, metal castings, forgings and stampings, industrial parts, animal cages, electronic components, tanks and reactors.

Used to remove: Soils, grit, grime, slime, grease, tars, resins, fats, oils, blood, tissue, particulates, inorganic residues, chemicals and solvents.

Surfaces cleaned: Recommended for glass, stainless steel, ceramic, cement and alkali-resistant plastics and metals such as stainless steel. Corrosion testing is advisable.

Cleaning method: Labware washers, dishwashers, washer-sterilizers, washer-sanitizers, cart washers, spray cabinet washers, electrocleaning, ultrasonic cleaners clean-in-place and manual cleaning.

Directions: Follow machine manufacturers directions. Not intended for powder detergent receptacles. If available, use liquid detergent reservoir, connecting tubes or metering pump. In general, use 1/2–1% solution in hot water wash cycle (1 1/4–2 1/2 tbsp per gal, 3/4–1 1/4 oz per gal, or 5–10 ml per L). Most machines need 2 1/2 oz added at a typical 2 gal. wash cycle. For soak, circulate or ultrasonic use, make a 1% solution in cold, warm or hot water. For difficult soils, raise water temperature and use more detergent. Wear protective gloves and

eyewear when handling. RINSE THOROUGHLY—preferably with running water. For critical cleaning, do final or all rinsing in distilled, deionized or purified water. For food contact surfaces, rinse with potable water. Used on a range of alkali resistant glass, ceramic, plastic and metal surfaces. Corrosion testing is advisable.
